Results from Year 4 Multiplication Times table Check 2023-24

In Year 4 children take part in an on-screen assessment designed to determine whether pupils can fluently recall their multiplication tables up to 12, through a set of timed questions.

There are 25 questions and no official pass mark. In Y4 this year there are 30 pupils. 1 pupil = 3.3%

Results from external testing end of Key Stage 2 – 2023-24

Pupils at St Mary's sit SATs (Standard Attainment Tests) at the end of year 6.

The data produced from these tests, includes all pupils including those who have Special Educational Needs (SEN), English as an Additional Language (EAL) and groups of learners who are unable to access school on a daily basis.

In Y6 this year, there are 30 pupils. 1 pupil = 3.3%
