Results from Year 4 Multiplication Times table Check 2025-26

In Year 4 children take part in an on-screen assessment designed to determine whether pupils can fluently recall their multiplication tables up to 12, through a set of timed questions.

There are 25 questions and no official pass mark. In Y4 this year there are 32 pupils. 1 pupil = 3.1%

Results from external testing end of Key Stage 2 – 2025-26

Pupils at St Mary's sit SATs (Standard Attainment Tests) at the end of year 6.
