

Results from external testing end of EYFS, Phonics and KS1 - 2019

Pupils at St Mary's are formally assessed at the end of Reception year (EYFS), sit a Phonics test in year 1 with resits in year 2, and SATs (Standard Attainment Tests) at the end of year 2.

The data produced as a result of these tests, includes all pupils including those who have Special Educational Needs (SEN), English as an Additional Language (EAL) and groups of learners who are unable to access school on a daily basis.

Please note that data includes all pupils in the cohort including those who were not able to meet the demands of the tests.

Reception data

Shows end of year data with pupils working towards achieving Early Learning Goals.

Achievement is measured through Good Level of Development (GLD).
