### Key Stage 2 External Assessments 2022-23

#### Results from Year 4 Multiplication Times table Check 2022-23

In Year 4 children take part in an on-screen assessment designed to determine whether pupils can fluently recall their multiplication tables up to 12, through a set of timed questions.

There are 25 questions and no official pass mark. At St Mary's 83% of year 4 scored 80% or more in their times table check.

#### Results from external testing end of Key Stage 2 – 2023

Pupils at St Mary's sit SATs (Standard Attainment Tests) at the end of year 6.

The data produced from these tests, includes all pupils including those who have Special Educational Needs (SEN), English as an Additional Language (EAL) and groups of learners who are unable to access school on a daily basis.

In Y6 this year, there were 28 pupils. 1 pupil = 3.5%
