$$\begin{array}{l} 10 + 6 = 16 \\ 9 + 4 = 13 \\ 3 + 6 = 9 \\ 11 + 4 = 15 \\ 17 + 3 = 20 \\ 12 + 6 = 18 \\ 11 + 8 = 19 \\ 8 + 4 = 12 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{l} 9 + 5 = 14 \\ 8 + 4 = 12 \\ 7 + 5 = 12 \\ 4 + 9 = 13 \\ 6 + 12 = 18 \\ 1 + 13 = 14 \\ 2 + 16 = 18 \\ 2 + 18 = 20 \end{array}$$
