Summer Term Curriculum For Reception Class

R.E:

The 'Come and See' topics this term are: 'Good News', 'Friends', 'Our World' and 'Islam'.

During these topics the children will be:

- Discovering that everyone has Good News to share and learning about Pentecost: the celebration of the Good News of Jesus.
- Understanding that Jesus had good friends and discovering what Jesus tells us about friendship.
- Discussing what we love and wonder about our world and understanding/appreciating that God gave us this wonderful world.
- Learning about Islam; important objects and traditions.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

We will be:

- Take care of the environment & living things.
- Know about people who help us.
- Become independent learners.
- Work as a team.

Communication and Language + Literacy:

In our lessons we will be:

- Use and apply our phase 3 sounds independently and begin to learn phase 4.
- Read and write independently.
- Label and write information developing our nonfiction skills.
- We will continue to develop our stories, letter and list writing.
- Ph3/4/5 in ability groups.

Mathematics: Number and Shape Space and Measure:

The children will be learning to:

- Solve practical problems using number skills.
- Create our own patterns.
- Tell the time to at least the hour.
- Use money in role play.
- Measure capacity and compare weights
- Double, halves and share items equally
- Count in 5's and 10's

Understanding the World:

The children will be given the opportunity to:

- Explore the environment; habitats; plants.
- Care for living things.
- Understand how food grows and how to look after the vegetables and harvest the crops.
- Make and explore simple maps.
- Use the computer - keyboard/word processing skills

Expressive Arts and Design:

The children will be given the opportunity to:

- Draw, paint, print, collage, textiles, 3D construction.
- Explore environmental sounds - patterns; rhythm games; dance.
- Adapt artwork / constructions and talking about why.
- Play imaginatively.

Physical Development:

We will be:

- Use the outdoors for games; small apparatus skills;
- Understand how exercise and healthy choices are important.
- Play team games.
- Weave
- Make musical instruments.

We will do games and athletics with Mr Capper and dance with Mrs North.
