Wildlife

Welcome to Wildlife my people! We'll be reading about dolphins TO-DAY, as well as finding and discover new-things.

What type of animal is a Dolphin?

Dolphins are mainly known as mammals as they give birth without giving birth to an animal that is in an egg.

What do they eat?

Dolphins eat fish. They are also carnivores, but their diet depends on their dolphin breed.

What are Dolphin Characteristics?

Their characteristics are that dolphins have smooth, rubbery skin and are usually a mixture of black, white and grey. They all have 2 flippers on the sides of their tail to help them swim easier. Like other whales, dolphins have a chunky blubber (fat) beneath their skin, that's why they're soft.

Where does it live?

Most dolphins are marine and live in the ocean or brackish water along the coastline.

They are suited to it's habitat, telling by their bodies being streamlined and their limbs being modified.

How do dolphins find their food?
 Dolphins like other whales, use echolocation to find food. They will make short clicks and listen for echoes, which reveal the location of the fish.
 I also forgot to mention, fish like saw-fish and mackerel make up large parts of some dolphins diets.

Key Facts

- There are currently 42 species of dolphins and seven species of porpoises.
- The orca (killer whale) is the largest dolphin.
- All dolphins have conical shaped teeth.
- Dolphins only sleep with help of their brains.

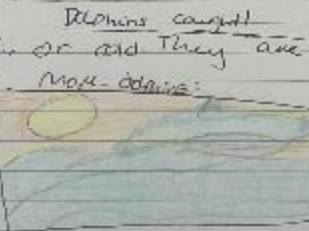
