


Free School Meal Vouchers

Year 1 have been learning estimate and measure accurately the volume of objects.






Year 1 have also been writing instructions on how to be fearsome dragons – I'm sure you'll agree they look very frightening!

Year 2 have been learning to create animations – and this time their creations are coronation focused. Look at their concentration!




