R.E:

This term we will be learning about creation and covenants.

We will learn:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

We will be learning to:

- Settle into the school routine.
- Agree the class rules.
- Make new friends.
- Learn to listen.
- Learn to share.

Literacy:

In our lessons we will:

- Learn about the front cover and back cover of a book
- Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.

Communication and Language:

- Develop their communication but may continue to have problems with irregular tenses and plurals, such as 'runned' for 'ran', 'swimmed' for 'swam'.
- Use longer sentences of four to six words. Start a conversation with an adult or a friend and continue it for many turns.
- Use talk to organise themselves and their play: "Let's go on a bus... you sit there... I'll be the driver."

Understanding the World:

The children will be given the opportunity to:

- Explore the environment in autumn
- Explore forces - ramps.
- Explore materials in our house.
- Learn about the five senses
- Talk about my family
- Making connections between features of their families and others.
- Talk about what they see outside

Expressive Arts and Design:

The children will be given the opportunity to:

- Draw, paint, print, collage, textiles, 3D construction.
- Sing nursery rhymes - explore beat.
- Recognise fast/slow; loud/quiet.
- Talk about preferences; likes/dislikes.
- Junk modelling, mixing media, colour mixing.
- Play imaginatively

Physical Development:

We will be:

- Developing our cutting skills.
- Putting on own coat.
- Moving up and down apparatus.
- Using the toilet independently
- Moving our bodies in different ways

Mathematics: Number and Shape Space and Measure:

The children will be learning to:

- Colours
- Match and sort
- compare amounts
- Exploring pattern
