Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

We will be learning about:

- Knowing our special people
- Talking about good friends
- Learning about how to stay safe on the internet

Communication and Language + Literacy:

In our lessons we will:

- Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.
- Continue writing our names
- Write lists of animals
- Clap syllables in our names and other words
- Sequencing stories
- Talking about different ways a story could end
- Spotting rhymes in our stories

Mathematics: Number and Shape Space and Measure:

The children will be learning to:

- Recite numbers to 15
- Learn the cardinal principle
- Recognise numbers
- Compare two groups of numbers using more than/fewer than
- Experiment with symbols and mark making
- Finding and naming 2D shapes, begin to talk about 3D shapes
- Respond to spatial and positional language
- Creating ABAB patterns

Understanding the World:

The children will be given the opportunity to:

- Learn about animals around the world
- Learnt the 7 continents through song
- Learn about life cycles
- Explore extinct animals - dinosaur and dodo bird
- Explore how things work and talk about different forces they feel
- Sow seeds and talk about new life
- Learn about nutrition and vegetables
- Grow vegetables

Expressive Arts and Design:

The children will be given the opportunity to:

- Improve cutting skills
- Making animal masks
- Explore the African/Asian drum and movement
- Copy and follow a steady beat. Then make their own beat
- Sing through repetition and explore various rhymes and tales
- Learn what it takes to be a farmer
- Show emotions in drawings using the Easter story

Physical Development:

We will be:
