During these topics the children will be:

- Learning about good news.
- Learning about the Holy Spirit
- Learning about the church being a special place
- Learning that we are all God's children

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

We will be learning about:

- Keeping safe
- Living in the wider world
- Aspirations, work and career: helping people earn money to pay for things

Communication and Language + Literacy:

In our lessons we will:

- Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.
- Writing letters of the alphabet
- Answer who, what, when, where and why questions in response to set texts
- Sequencing stories, writing stories, illustrating stories
- Spotting rhymes in our stories

Mathematics: Number and Shape Space and Measure:

The children will be learning to:

- Recite numbers to 20
- Link numerals to amounts up to 5
- Recognising numbers of personal significance
- Compare quantities using correct vocabulary
- Use 2D and 3D shapes to create models
- Practically explore positional language
- Recognising repeated patterns and discussing them

Understanding the World:

The children will be given the opportunity to:

- Explore materials, metals, plastics and wood
- There are many people who help us. Identify them and learn about them.
- Learn that we live on earth. It is the best suitable planet for us
- Learn about creation
- Learn about the 7 continents and countries around the world
- Learn about different careers and occupations

Expressive Arts and Design:

The children will be given the opportunity to:

- Improve cutting skills
- Use shapes to draw/make homes, buildings etc
- Learn to fold and making paper airplanes
- Use instruments to distinguish the different sounds
- Dress up in different occupations
- Learn to weave using the earth as a template
