No earrings on Monday!

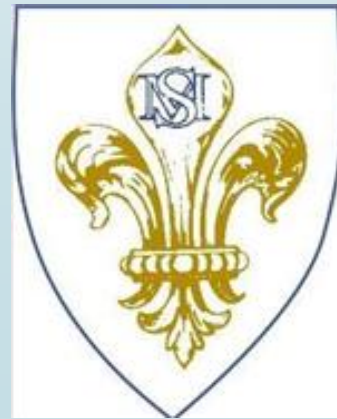
Directly from the website and uniform policy:
